**Item No-1**

Heard Advocate P Deepak , the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Jojo Iype and Adv. Jithesh Menon represented the objector. This is an application filed for fresh regular permit in respect of a 2012 model or suitable stage carriage with seating capacity not less than 33 in all to operate on the route Paigottoor- Kothamangalam (Via) Pothanikad, Koovalloor, Adivad, Kudamunda, Kuthukuzhy and One single trip (via) Mavudy , Adivad, Kudamunda as ordinary service.

This authority considered the matter in detail and reveals the following. As per the application submitted for the grant of regular permit, the applicant offered a 2012 model stage carriage or suitable vehicle with seating capacity not less than 33 in all.

In the previous sittings, this authority specified the description of the stage carriages for granting fresh regular permits and decided that no fresh regular permit shall be granted to stage carriages older than five years from the date of its original registration ,considering the aspects of road safety and in the light of Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in C.A No.5227/2013 dtd 04/08/2010.

Aggrieved on this, some of the applicants approached the hon'ble high court and the hon'ble court vide judgment in WP© 33980 of 2015(V) dated 15/12/2016, disposed the related petitions directing the State Transport Authority to take a decision as to the maximum age of the vehicles to be used for conducting ordinary stage carriage services in the state, within three months since it is a matter affecting the stage carriage operators through out the state. STA had taken this matter as an item in its meeting held on 14/06/2017 and the decision is awaiting.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the application for the grant of regular permit is adjourned. Secretary RTA is directed to place the application before this authority, after the decision of STA in this regard.

**Item No-2**

Heard Advocate P Deepak , the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri C M Meeran. This is an application for fresh regular permit in respect of a 2012 model or suitable stage carriage with seating capacity not less than 33 in all to operate on the route Kottappady-Kothamangalam - Muvattupuzha touching Pothanikad and Uppukandam (Via) Ayappara, Thrikkariyoor, Puthuppady, Mulavoor, Irumalapady, Pidavoor, Adivad, Karingazha and Muthankuzhy as ordinary service .

This authority considered the matter in detail and reveals the following. As per the application submitted for the grant of regular permit, the applicant offered a 2012 model stage carriage or suitable vehicle with seating capacity not less than 33 in all.

In the previous sittings, this authority specified the description of the stage carriages for granting fresh regular permits and decided that no fresh regular permit shall be granted to stage carriages older than five years from the date of its original registration, considering the aspects of road safety and in the light of Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in C.A No.5227/2013 dtd 04/08/2010.

Aggrieved on this, some of the applicants approached the hon'ble high court and the hon'ble court vide judgment in WP© 33980 of 2015(V) dated 15/12/2016, disposed the related petitions directing the State Transport Authority to take a decision as to the maximum age of the vehicles to be used for conducting ordinary stage carriage services in the state, within three months since it is a matter affecting the stage carriage operators through out the state. STA had taken this matter as an item in its meeting held on 14/06/2017 and the decision is awaiting.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the application for the grant of regular permit is adjourned. Secretary RTA is directed to place the application before this authority, after the decision of STA in this regard.

### **Item No-3**

Heard the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Babu M C. This is an application filed for fresh regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL 06 D 5743 with seating capacity 38 in all to operate on the route Chooramudy- Perumbavoor- Kolencherry (Via) Mudakuzha, Kuruppampady, Vengola, Arackapady and Pattimattom as ordinary service.

This authority considered the matter in detail and reveals the following. As per the application submitted for the grant of regular permit, the applicant offered the S/c KL 06 D 5743 which is a 2006 model vehicle with seating capacity 38 in all.

In the previous sittings, this authority specified the description of the stage carriages for granting fresh regular permits and decided that no fresh regular permit shall be granted to stage carriages older than five years from the date of its original registration, considering the aspects of road safety and in the light of Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in C.A No.5227/2013 dtd 04/08/2010.

Aggrieved on this, some of the applicants approached the hon'ble high court and the hon'ble court vide judgment in WP© 33980 of 2015(V) dated 15/12/2016, disposed the related petitions directing the State Transport Authority to take a decision as to the maximum age of the vehicles to be used for conducting ordinary stage carriage services in the state, within three months since it is a matter affecting the stage carriage operators through out the state. STA had taken this matter as an item in its meeting held on 14/06/2017 and the decision is awaiting.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the application for the grant of regular permit is adjourned. Secretary RTA is directed to place the application before this authority, after the decision of STA in this regard.

#### **Item No-4**

Heard Advocate P Deepak , the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Abraham Mathew. This is an application filed for fresh regular permit in respect of a new or suitable stage carriage with seating capacity not less than 28 in all to operate on the route Arakkunnam- Perumbavoor (Via) Edakkattuvayal, Oliyapuram, Vattappara, Peppathy, Piravom, Kakkad, Kottappuram, Kolencherry, Mazhuvannoor, Valamboor, Valayanchirangara, Thuruthipilly, Allapara, Vengola, Pattimattom and kadayiruppu as ordinary service .

This authority considered the matter in detail and reveals the following. As per the application submitted for the grant of regular permit, the applicant offered 2012 model stage carriage or suitable vehicle with seating capacity not less than 33 in all.

In the previous sittings, this authority specified the description of the stage carriages for granting fresh regular permits and decided that no fresh regular permit shall be granted to stage carriages older than five years from the date of its original registration ,considering the aspects of road safety and in the light of Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in C.A No.5227/2013 dtd 04/08/2010.

Aggrieved on this, some of the applicants approached the hon'ble high court and the hon'ble court vide judgment in WP© 33980 of 2015(V) dated 15/12/2016, disposed the related petitions directing the State Transport Authority to take a decision as to the maximum age of the vehicles to be used for conducting ordinary stage carriage services in the state, within three months since it is a matter affecting the stage carriage operators through out the state. #### **Item No-5**

Heard Adv. Jithesh Menon, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri .N O Jose. This is an application filed for the renewal of regular permit in respect of Stage Carriage KL-44 B 6975 operating on the route Kothamangalam- Thodupuzha -Pothanikad (Via) Muvattupuzha and Vazhakulam as Ordinary moffusil Service.

This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the renewal of permit in the light of existing notifications and connected file . This is an inter district route and 04 km lies under the jurisdiction of RTA Idukki, which comes under the purview of general concurrence. The route portion from Thodupuzha to Muvattupuzha BOC In overlaps with the notified scheme, Aluva- Kattappana published vide GO(P) No. 42/2009/Tran dtd. 14.7.2009 . The regular permit in was issued on 17/10/1997 . Since the STU has not filed new application on this route till date, there is no impediment to renew the permit for continuous operation in view of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017 and the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C ) No. 14793/2006 and connected cases. Hence renewal of regular permit is granted to Stage Carriage KL-44 B 6975 operating on the route Kothamangalam- Thodupuzha -Pothanikad subject to the effect of clause (4)of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017.

### **Item No-6**

Heard Adv. Jithesh Menon, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Abookacker P . M. This is an application filed for renewal of regular permit in respect of S/C KL 44 D 5806 on the route Vellakkayam- Muvattupuzha (Via) Mullaringad, Paigottoor, Pothanikad, Kozhippilly, Kothamanglam and Karukadam as ordinary service .

This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the renewal of permit in the light of existing notifications and connected file . This is an inter district route having route length of 46 km out of which 04 km lies under the jurisdiction of RTA Idukki, and is comes under the purview of general concurrence. The regular permit was issued on 02/04/2007 and the route overlaps a distance of 2km from Muvattupuzha BOC Jn to Latha Bus stand with the notified scheme Aluva- Kattappana published vide GO(P) No. 42/2009/Tran dtd. 14.7.2009 and the distance of overlapping is within the prescribed limit. Since the STU has not filed new application on this route till date, there is no impediment to renew the permit for continuous operation in view of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017 and the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C ) No. 14793/2006 and connected cases. Hence renewal of regular permit is granted to Stage Carriage KL 44 D 5806 on the route Vellakkayam- Muvattupuzha subject to the effect of clause (4) of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017.

### **Item No-7**

Heard Adv. C.D Anitha, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Siji Varghese. This is an application filed for renewal of regular permit in respect of S/C KL 44 D 8797 on the route Thodupuzha- Kothamangalam- Perumannoor (Via) Kalloorkkad, Vazhakulam,, Ayavana, Varappetty and Nadukani . This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the renewal of permit in the light of existing notifications and connected file . This is an inter district route having route length of 45.5 km out of which 07 km lies under the jurisdiction of RTA Idukki, and is comes under the purview of general concurrence. The regular permit was issued on 02/03/1995 and the route overlaps a distance of 2.5 km from Thodupuzha to Vengalloor with the notified scheme Aluva- Kattappana published vide GO(P) No. 42/2009/Tran dtd. 14.7.2009.

Since the STU has not filed new application on this route till date, there is no impediment to renew the permit for continuous operation in view of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017 and the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C ) No. 14793/2006 and connected cases. Hence renewal of regular permit is granted to Stage Carriage KL 44 D 8797 on the route Thodupuzha- Kothamangalam- Perumannoor subject to the effect of clause (4) of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017.

### **Item No-8**

Heard Adv. Jithesh Menon, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Jins Joy. This is an application filed for renewal of regular permit in respect of S/C KL 10 AD 5825 operating on the route Koothattukulam-Thripunithura (Via) Kakkoor, Anchalpetty, Ramamangalam, Poothrikka, Choondy, Puthencruz, Karimugal, and Hill Palace as ordinary service. This authority in its earlier meeting held on 17/11/2016 considered the application and adjourned till the finalization of the draft scheme published vide no-489/B1/2015/tran dtd 17/02/2016 related with exceptional clause of intermediate points mentioned in the Ernakulam- Muvattupuzha scheme .

Now the scheme is finalized as GO(p) No 05/2017/Tran dated 21/02/2017 and as per clause (4) of the order the existing regular permits in the private sector as on the date of publication of the scheme will be allowed to operate service . This permit was seen issued on 16/10/2006 and the now the application is to effect the renewal of permit in the light of above govt order. This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the renewal of permit in the light of existing notifications and connected file . This is an intra district route having route length 43.5 km. There is an overlapping of 6 Km from Puthencruz to Kolencherry and 2 Km from Thripunithura to Hill Palace with the notified route Muvattupuzha- Ernakulam.

This authority feels no impediment to renew the permit for continuous operation in view of GO(p) No 5/2017/Tran dated 21/02/2017. Hence renewal of regular permit is granted to Stage Carriage KL 10 AD 5825 on the route Koothattukulam-Thripunithura subject to the effect of clause (4) of GO(p) No 5/2017/Tran dated 21/02/2017.

#### **Item No-9**

Heard Adv. Jithesh Menon, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri .Rajesh V S. This is an application for the renewal of regular permit in respect of Stage Carriage KL-17 M 9599 operating on the route Muvattupuzha- Thodupuzha as Ordinary moffusil Service.

This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the renewal of permit in the light of existing notifications and connected file . This is an inter district route and 04 km lies under the jurisdiction of RTA Idukki, which comes under the purview of general concurrence. The regular permit was issued prior to 09/05/2006 and the entire route overlaps with the notified scheme, Aluva- Kattappana published vide GO(P) No. 42/2009/Tran dtd. 14.7.2009 .

Since the STU has not filed new application on this route till date, there is no impediment to renew the permit for continuous operation in view of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017 and the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C ) No. 14793/2006 and connected cases. Hence renewal of regular permit is granted to Stage Carriage KL-17 M 9599 operating on the route Muvattupuzha- Thodupuzha subject to the effect of clause (4) of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017

#### **Item No-10**

A) Heard Adv. C D Anitha, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Prasad P N .This is a request for condonation of delay for submitting the renewal of permit application in respect of S/C KL-38 6364 operating on the route Vattappara-Kothamangalam. This authority satisfied the explanation of the applicant and request allowed.

B) This is an application for renewal of regular permit in respect of stage Carriage KL-38 6364 operating on the route Vattappara-Kothamangalam as Ordinary moffusil Service.

This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the renewal of permit in the light of existing notifications and connected file . This is an intra district route and the regular permit was issued prior to 09/05/2006 . There is an overlapping of 2.5 Km with the notified scheme, Kottayam- Kozhikode published vide GO(P) No. 42/2009/Tran dtd. 14.7.2009 .

Since the STU has not filed new application on this route till date, there is no impediment to renew the permit for continuous operation in view of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017 and the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C ) No. 14793/2006 and connected cases.

Hence renewal of regular permit is granted to Stage Carriage KL-38 6364 operating on the route Vattappara-Kothamangalam subject to the effect of clause (4) of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017.

**Item No-11**

A) Heard Adv. Deepak, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Jiji Thomas. This is a request for condonation of delay for submitting the renewal of permit application in respect of S/C KL-17 E 1177 operating on the route Kanichattupara- Aluva. This authority satisfied the explanation of the applicant and request allowed.

B) This is an application for renewal of regular permit in respect of stage Carriage KL-17 E 1177 operating on the route Kanichattupara- Aluva as Ordinary moffusil Service.

This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the renewal of permit in the light of existing notifications and connected file. This is an intra district route and the regular permit was issued prior to 09/05/2006. There is an overlapping of 1.5 Km with the notified scheme, Aluva- Kattappana published vide GO(P) No. 42/2009/Tran dtd. 14.7.2009. Since the STU has not filed new application on this route till date, there is no impediment to renew the permit for continuous operation in view of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017 and the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C) No. 14793/2006 and connected cases. Hence renewal of regular permit is granted to Stage Carriage KL-17 E 1177 operating on the route **Kanichattupara- Aluva** subject to the effect of clause (4) of GO(p) No 8/2017/Tran dated 23/03/2017.

**Item No-12**

Heard Adv P. Deepak, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri P S George. This is an application filed for variation of regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL-40/884 operating on the route Akanad - Palissery touching Malayattoor Adivaram (Via) Perumbavoor, Kalady, Angamaly, Kuruppampady and Kodamand as ordinary service. The variation sought for is an additional trip from Akanad to Malayattor at 6.15 pm.

This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the variation application in the light of enquiry report furnished by the field officer, objections raised by the public, KSRTC and connected file. This authority feels that the proposed additional trip from Akanadu to Malayattoor (via) Kurichilakodu will be beneficial to the travelling public from Perumbavor to have a direct access to Malayattoor area, as it provides additional transportation facility. Hence the applied variation is granted subject to settlement of timings.

**Item No-13**

Heard Adv P. Deepak, the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Devassy. This is an application filed for variation of regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL-06 C 6151 operating on the route Kanichattupara- Perumbavoor- Aluva (via) Panachiyam, Odackaly, Kuruppampady and trips to Peechamugal (Via) Vattakkattupady as ordinary service. The permit is desired to be varied so as to operate the present return trip from Peechanamugal to Perumbvaoor (via) Manackapady and Iringole post office instead of Vattakkattupady. It is also desired to operate an addition trip to Peechanamugal (via) on the above route at 10.06 am from Perumbavoor.

This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the variation application in the light of enquiry report furnished by the field officer, objections raised by the public, KSRTC and connected file. It is reported that the route portion from Manackapady to Iringole post office (via) Iringole kavu a distance of 1.9 km is virgin . Hence Secretary RTA is directed to obtain necessary fitness certificate for the virgin portion from PWD authorities. Hence adjourned.

**Item No-14**

Heard Adv. Jithesh Menon the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Binu G Vadath. This is an application filed for variation of regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL-05 U 2628 operating on the route Kolencherry- Kothamangalam (Via) Poothrikka, Ramamangalam, Kayanad, Marady, Muvattupuzha and Puthuppady as ordinary service as Maneed- Kothamangalam (Via) Ezhakkaranad, Ramamangalam, Kayanad, Marady, Muvattupuzha and Puthuppady as ordinary service. The proposed variation includes curtailment of 8 km (Ramamangalam to Kolencherry) and extension of 6 km (Ramamangalam to Maneed ). This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the variation application in the light of enquiry report furnished by the field officer, objections raised by the public, KSRTC and connected file. There is no overlapping in the variation portion as the route proceeds through non notified route. Copy of the resolution of Maneed grama panchayath dtd 05/04/2017 favoring the proposed variation is also received. Considering all these facts, this authority feels that even though the route curtail a distance of 2 kms from Poothrikka to Kinginimattom ,the proposed extension of route from Ramamangalam to Maneed will overlook the detriments and will be more helpful to the travelling public including students of St.Mary's middle school Vettithara. Hence the applied variation subject to settlement of timings.

**Item No-15**

Heard Adv. Jithesh Menon the learned counsel represented the applicant Sri Noushad. This is an application filed for variation of regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL-38 6899 operating on the route Kavakkad- Muvattupuzha- Uppukandam (Via) Ayavana and Kothamangalam with trip to Pothanikad (Via) Kuthukuzhy and Kudamunda as ordinary service . The permit is desired to be varied as Kavakkad- Muvattupuzha- Uppukandam with deviation of route in the 11.20 trip (7<sup>h</sup> trip) to Pothanikad (Via) Pidavoor instead of Kuthukuzhy & Kudamunda as ordinary service without changing existing timings. This authority elaborately considered the scope and applicability of the variation application in the light of enquiry report furnished by the field officer, objections raised by the public, KSRTC and connected file. There is no overlapping in the variation portion as the route proceeds through non notified route. It is also reported that even though the proposed deviation includes curtailment of route (Kuthukuzhy- Kudamunda), the benefits due to the variation outweigh the detriments since the density of population and number education institutions (Via ) Kozhippilly Jn & Pidavoor are much more than existing route. Considering all these facts, this authority felt that the proposed variation will be help ful to the common public. Hence the applied variation is granted subject to settlement of timings only in the variation portion .

**Item No-16**

Heard Adv. C D Anitha ,the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/C KL 35 A 3299 operating on the route Kunackal Ferry- Piravom. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-17.**

Heard Adv. C D Anitha ,the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/ KL 17 F 2564 operating on the route Thripunithura- Kolencherry- Kuravilangad. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-18**

Heard Adv. C D Anitha ,the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/c KL 40 A 2321 operating on the route Nellad- Muvattupuzha- Perumbavoor. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-19**

Applicants absent. Hence adjourned.

**Item No-20**

Heard Adv. C D Anitha ,the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/c KL 40 C 3212 operating on the route Kavumpuram- Kaloor. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-21**

Heard the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/ C KL 40 C 9160 operating on the route Panamkuzhy- Karukappilly .Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-22**

Heard the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/c KL 44 C 7513 operating on the route Vadattupara- Perumbavoor- Pinvoorkudy. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-23**

Heard the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/C KL-02 T 8326 operating on the route Mannoor- Perumbavoor- Kolencherry. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-24**

Heard Adv. P .Deepak, the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/C KL 06 B 9600 operating on the route Angamaly- Kolencherry. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-25**

Heard Adv. C D Anitha, the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/ C KL 03 H 9234 operating on the route Koothattukulam- Kolencherry Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-26**

Heard Adv. C D Anitha, the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/C KL 67 3860 operating on the route Thodupuzha- Kothamanglam. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-27**

Heard Adv. P.Deepak, the learned counsel represented both the applicants. This is an application for transfer of permit in respect of S/C KL 03 N 6535 operating on the route Perumbavoor- Thripunithura. Transfer of permit is allowed as applied for subject to the clearance of Government dues if any.

**Item No-28**

This is the request of secretary RTA Idukki for the grant of fresh regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL 44 D 9475 to operate on the route Ernakulam –Munnar(Via) Medical Centre, Vazhakkala, HMT, NAD, Cochin Bank Jn, South Vazhakulam, Perumbavoor, Kothamanglam, Neriamanglam, Adimaly and Anachal as LSOS.

As per the report of the MVI Muvattupuzha a distance of 47 Km from Neriamangalam to South Vazhakulam (Via) Kothamangalam and Perumbavoor comes under the jurisdiction of this authority. There is an overlapping of 1.5 Km from Perumbavoor(Kalady Jn ) to Palakkattutazham with the notified scheme Aluva- Kattappana.

Hence concurrence is granted without prejudice to the right of the primary authority to decide the nature of service depending on the route length.

**Item No-29**

This is the request of secretary RTA Idukki for the renewal of regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL 44 A 1002 to operate on the route Aluva–Rajakkad (Via) South Vazhakulam, Perumbavoor, Kothamanglam, Neriamanglam, Adimaly Anachal and Kunjithanny and one cut trip between Aluva and Kothamangalam as LSOS.

As per the report of the MVI Muvattupuzha a distance of 47 Km from Neriamangalam to South Vazhakulam (Via) Kothamangalam and Perumbavoor comes under the jurisdiction of this authority. There is an overlapping of 1.5 Km from Perumbavoor(Kalady Jn ) to Palakkattutazham with the notified scheme Aluva- Kattappana.

Hence concurrence is granted without prejudice to the right of the primary authority to decide the nature of service depending on the route length.

**Item No-30**

This is the request of secretary RTA Idukki for the grant of fresh regular permit in respect of stage carriage KL 40 K 4275 to operate on the route Thrikkariyoor- Adimaly (Via) Malayankeezhu, Kothamangalam, Neriamangalam as LSOS.

As per the report of the MVI Muvattupuzha a distance of 24 Km from Neriamangalam to Thrikkariyoor (Via) Kothamanglam comes under the jurisdiction of this authority. There is no overlapping with any of the notified scheme .

Hence concurrence is granted without prejudice to the right of the primary authority to decide the nature of service depending on the route length.

**Item No-31**

Perused the GO(P) No. 05/2017/Tran dtd 21/02/2017 and GO(P) No. 08/2017/Tran dtd 23/03/2017 and delegated the Secretary RTA to,

1.Renew all intra district ordinary and limited stop stage permits granted up to 14/07/2009 subject to the compliance of provisions of schemes.

2.Renew all inter district stage carriage permit granted up to 14/07/2009 and having distance only up to 20 km in the neighboring districts.

Provided that, Secretary RTA is delegated to renew such permits subject to compliance of other provisions of the scheme in the case of stage carriage permits which overlaps the notified routes published vide GO(P) No.05/2017/Tran dtd 21/02/2017 only.

**Item No-32**

Perused the records. Heard the learned counsel represented bus operators forum and the representative of Rayamangalam grama panchayath. Secretary RTA is directed to conduct a detailed enquiry in this matter and issue notice to the Panchayath authorities . On receipt of the above place before the very next meeting. Hence adjourned.

**Item No-33**

Perused the records. The stage carriage KL 17 B 8797 was permitted to operate on the route Vadattupara- Kothamangalam- Muvattupuzha with valid permit up to 02/01/2017. It is reported that, on 15/12/2015 the permit holder had availed clearance certificate retaining the permit under suspended animation in the light of judgment in WP© 36249 of 2015 dtd 07/12/2015 of hon'ble high court.

The time period for replacement with a suitable vehicle expired on 14-04-2016 and the permit holder had neither applied for replacement nor for renewal of permit within the stipulated time . Hence the regular issue in respect of S/c KL 17 B 8797 to operate on the route Vadattupara- Kothamangalam- Muvattupuzha is hereby revoked.
